*Job Description*

***Purpose:***

To coordinate and deliver part of our programme of work with children and young people.

***Responsibilities:***

- Development and coordination of Nexus, our midweek open youth club.
- Development and coordination of Super Study Space, our Saturday morning homework club.
- To ensure that our activities for children and young people remain connected with other projects in Erdington and beyond.
- To explore and liaise with other community initiatives for children and young people.
- To liaise, as appropriate, with families of children and young people accessing our services.
- To ensure that the children's and young peoples' activities are in keeping with the church's safeguarding policy, liaising as appropriate with the church Safeguarding Policy.
- Other reasonable duties as required.

Basic = average 8 hours per week.

Salary = £20,020 per annum (£11 per hour/£4576 pro rata).

*Fixed term for period of 12 months. Probationary period of 3 months.*

*Accountable to and supported by the Deacons and Minister. Supervised by the Minister and the Deacon responsible for Children's and Young People's work.*
