"I pray that God protect me and cover me with his blood as I care for these vulnerable people who are infected with the covid-19 and those who are not and need our help. I also pray for the families who have lost a love one due to the virus that they may find strength in you dear God. Heavenly father as we help out the hospitals with the covid-19 patients I pray that you cover me with your anointing from all sickness and diseases that I may not bring home anything to my family. These are very sad times for us all but God let us not forget that you are lord of all lord and king of all kings and that you deserve all the glory and all the honour. Amen."

Let everyone feel your power and love and comfort. Especially those who have not been able to be with a dying loved one.

For care workers in residential homes who have lost multiple residents whom they have cared for years.

Thankyou that we have come this far with many of our friends and family fit and well.

Nature is flourishing and people are noticing.

You are our light throughout and not just at the end of the tunnel which may be just coming into view now.

Let us have learned new lessons from this and take those lessons forward after this corona era, especially perhaps our new found reliance and strength in you. Amen."
