

Returning to church for Sunday services.

The Covid-19 Pandemic has had a massive and unprecedented impact on all areas of our lives. With regard to church life, it means that we need to ensure that all usage of our building enables people to both feel, and be, as safe as possible. At the same time we need to balance this with maintaining our distinctly Christian ways of being: with regard to worship, servanthood, welcome, justice and inclusivity.

Therefore we feel it is important that all people accessing our premises are aware that we have:-

- taken heed of all relevant Government guidelines and have benefitted from information provided by the Baptist Union of Great Britain.
- undertaken a full and thorough risk assessment of all areas.
- required that all groups and activities have a risk assessment in place.
- increased the levels of cleaning.
- provided necessary PPE and Covid-Safe resources and signage.

If you wish to attend a Sunday service (10.30-11.00am). You need to note as follows:-

We are alternating how we do Sunday services: Week 1 is for adults (no children) and Week 2 is for families with children.

In order to attend you must book in by texting or phoning 07775465062. Only attend on the Sunday if you have had confirmation that you have a place.

Do not attend if you have any Covid 19 symptoms-

- high temperature; persistent cough; loss of taste or smell
- or you know or suspect you have Covid-19 at this time.

- We will take your temperature before you enter the building.
- You will need to use hand sanitiser on entry and wear a face covering whilst you are in the building.
- There will be no congregational singing and no refreshments.

But, we will be together and worshipping! It is just different and it is how we have to do it for now.
